Employers today are facing a 37% skills gap between what they want in entry-level employees and what the typical entrylevel candidate can offer. Strengthening student career readiness, defined by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE), as "the attainment and demonstration of requisite competencies that broadly prepare college graduates for a successful transition into the workplace" will close this persistent skills gap.

International Internships provide students the unique opportunity to shape their career readiness through a work experience abroad. In the process, they develop an international professional network before joining the full-time workforce. Further, they simultaneously begin to acquire the intercultural competence, foundational skills, and emotional intelligence today's employers are seeking in their employees. Accounting Internship Abroad

Note: Accounting internships will require candidates to have completed multiple upper division accounting and/or finance courses.

Job Description

Working alongside the accounting team at their internship site, the intern will perform a variety of accounting support tasks and projects. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Processing invoices in a database and reconciling statements
- Analyzing, reporting, and forecasting organizational data
- Preparing financial documents (balance sheets, invoices, income statements, etc.)
- Assisting in financial planning and budgeting

Competency & Skill Development

CEA Internships Abroad aligns each internship and the seminar course to the skills essential for graduates to be considered career ready by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE).

Below is an example of some of the competency and skill development a CEA Internship Abroad has included in past placements. Each internship will focus on the unique goals of the intern and industry which will be identified throughout the interview and coaching process.

Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

- 1. Manage data to build financial models on excel and analyze data to understand the main drivers in order to control the process.
- 2. Recognize economic and accounting principles and practices, financial markets, and banking.
- 3. Demonstrate ethical business and management principles included in planning, analysis, and presentation of work.

NACE Competency & Skill Development:



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Advertising interns will work closely with the strategic planning teams to support marketing and sales teams. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Researching, analyzing, and presenting categories, consumers, and media landscapes
- Formulating brand and communication strategies for the organization's or client's brands
- Tracking digital traffic through SEO, website leads, and social media engagement
- Developing and presenting a market strategy to the organization's marketing team
- Implementing an approved marketing strategy and tracking results

Competency & Skill Development

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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

- 1. Execute a marketing strategy, track results, and adapt strategy based on the analysis of the strategy.
- 2. Develop effective communication skills to persuade consumers and articulate ideas with colleagues.
- 3. Demonstrate critical thinking skills in a recommendation to create or change marketing strategies.

Agricultural interns will experience hands on projects with an emphasis on agriculturally related business development and activities. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Assisting with hands on work activities such as farming, research, or other agricultural labor opportunities at the host organization
- Coordinating logistics and other business operations
- Maintaining, analyzing, and presenting data to inform organizational operations and decisions
- Understanding and communicating government and regulatory information to colleagues and clients
- Establishing standards for products, processes, and procedures

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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

1. Research, evaluate, and manage data to determine compliance with regulatory standards in the local country and compare to US practices.

- 2. Communicate effectively in written reports and with colleagues and clients.
- 3. Demonstrate critical thinking skills in defensive of recommendations and decisions.

Arts interns will use their research skills to collect information. Interns will be asked to make judgements regarding this through both observation and review of data. Some duties will include:

- Integrating and developing visual elements to produce desired effects
- Receiving visitors at the service and meeting points for tours and accompanying the tours to perform support tasks
- Repairing, restoring, and reassembling artifacts

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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

- 1. Design and arrange artifacts or products of exhibition, report their condition, and identify/correct any problems with set up.
- 2. Assist with pre- and post-production paperwork, administration, and transcribing.
- 3. Organize campaigns, photoshoots, and visiting design fairs.

NACE Competency & Skill Development:





Intern in a fluid role to understand each business function and better manage and assist business operations effectively. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Preparing strategy development and recommending opportunities to improve business practices
- Managing projects across cross-functional departments
- Performing and presenting market analysis research
- Supporting day-to-day operations of the business and administration
- Analyzing business and/or financial data

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
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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

Culinary Arts interns will work to learn the ins and outs of being a chef—from managing a cooking class to a restaurant, interns will utilize their technical cooking skills to successfully execute each day. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Assisting with assessment of restaurant business performance
- Aiding in the preparation of food and tasting of recipes
- Conducting research on clients and new products
- Supporting marketing activities by managing social media and website content

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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

- 1. Analyze and plan restaurant sales levels and profitability.
- 2. Assist with and support the preparation of food and the reports regarding staff control.
- 3. Create content for culinary and drink blogs.

NACE Competency & Skill Development:



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Culture interns can work in a wide variety of different placements, ranging from NGO-related work to museum curating. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Developing outreach initiatives that help children receive education in developing areas of the country or other nations
- Translating tour information to museum visitors or giving tours in English
- Managing social media content creation and posting to social media websites

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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

- 1. Evaluate strategies for community outreach.
- 2. Assist with content creation for organization websites and blogs.
- 3. Organize campaigns and communication strategies.

Design interns will leverage their attention to detail skills with technical skills to create a variety of work within the design scope. Some duties may include but are not limited to:

- Sketching rough and detailed drawings of apparel or accessories and writing specifics details related to themes, construction, and material
- Creating designs and concepts based on client requests and requirements
- Preparing information regarding design, structure specifications, and contract documents

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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

- 1. Support the organization in website, application, social media, and promotion design.
- 2. Analyze research to support planning for applications and discuss consenting process on behalf of private clients.
- 3. Create designs related to fashion, assist in photo shooting, and organize campaigns.

NACE Competency & Skill Development:





Interns will have the opportunity to use their knowledge of design techniques, media production, and communication to compose and produce visual arts. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Assisting in creation of audiovisual material by filming, editing, and designing
- Researching and writing articles related to the organization's programming
- Designing print and online materials

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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

- 1. Create and design new art for product exhibits, displays, or promotional materials.
- 2. Collaborate with others to develop or refine designs.
- 3. Identify the strengths and weaknesses of current design strategy surrounding marketing and promotion.

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Interns will put their education coursework knowledge into practice in schools, NGO's, and other educational organizations. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Assisting and developing classroom activities including preparing lessons and educational games/activities
- Developing strategies, tools, and resources that complement lessons while adjusting to the varied educational needs of children
- Writing grants to receive additional funding for new programming and educational opportunities
- Researching innovative social engagement opportunities at an international level and integrating into the organization

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Note: Finance internships will require candidates to have completed multiple upper division accounting and/or finance courses.

Job Description

Finance interns can gain experience in a variety of finance-related roles including data analysis, wealth management, tax, investments, consulting, and more. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Analyzing, reporting, and preparing of research to identify new markets and/or products
- Evaluating portfolios of assets and investments
- Reconciling of banking data, sales invoices, and other financial documents
- Comparing past expenses and making recommendations for improvements and budgets
- Tracking payments, records, and daily transactions within a finance software

Competency & Skill Development

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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

- 1. Manage data within financial software to make decisions and recommendations on budgets.
- 2. Recognize economic and financial principles and practices, financial markets, and banking.
- 3. Demonstrate ethical business and management principles included in the planning, analysis, and presentation of work.

Interns will focus on scientific research and the business development of the organization gaining a holistic view of the food science industry. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Conducting scientific research for the development of new or improved products
- Evaluating quality of materials and/or products

- Shadowing within various departments at the organization (finance, marketing, etc.)

Note: Health-related internships allow interns to understand global health issues and support services. Health-related internships commonly focus on the administrative, educational, and/or support of the industry and do not often include patient-facing work.

Job Description

Interns will support health-related initiatives at the organization and learn about the health issues that affect the region. Some duties can include but are not limited to:

- Supporting research teams in collecting and analyzing data on health issues
- Preparing and distributing health education programming for clients at a local NGO and discussing patient cases and care
- Writing fundraising grants to support programming for refugees or other clients
- Assisting trainers and nutritionists in personalized care

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Industry Specific Competency & Skill Development:

- 1. Demonstrate ethical judgement and make recommendations on improvements to health initiatives.
- 2. Articulate health issues that affect the local region as they compare to common health issues in the US.
- 3. Understand methods for programming design, teaching, and assessment of programs given to clients.

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
