

# Placement Process: Checklist & Deadlines

#### 4+ MONTHS

BEFORE YOUR PROGRAM START DATE

# Enrollment Stage

Begin your CEA CAPA internship journey by applying to the internship program and submitting all required documents for consideration.

# What you'll do...

Submit the CEA CAPA application and required internship materials.

#### **DEADLINE**

Submit all required documents by your program's application deadline.

## 3-4 MONTHS

BEFORE YOUR PROGRAM START DATE

# Coaching Stage

Once accepted into the CEA CAPA internship program, you will start working with your assigned U.S.-based Internship Specialist. They will provide professional feedback on your résumé and statement of interest, set expectations for your experience abroad, and enroll you in the Global Internship Prep Modules.

# What you'll do...

- Complete the Global Internship Prep Modules.
- Revise your résumé and statement of interest based on the feedback from the modules and your Internship Specialist.

#### **DEADLINE**

Complete the Global Internship Prep Modules within 7 days of being enrolled.

## 2-3 MONTHS

# Matching Stage

During this stage, you will be waiting to hear from your incountry Internship Coordinator about potential opportunities. They may contact you to learn more about your background and expectations and to request additional document revisions.

Note: Because this is a global internship matching process, several weeks may pass before you are contacted about your potential placement.

# What you'll do...

- Review the Interviewing

  Module to refresh your

  interview skills and prepare

  for your upcoming host

  organization interview.
- Optional: Schedule a mock interview with your school's Career Center.

#### DEADLINE

After completing the
Prep Modules, it may take
30-60 days to hear from
your Internship Coordinator.
Use this time to prepare for
your interview.

#### 1-2 MONTHS

# Interview Stage

Your Internship Coordinator will email you a position description for your potential placement.
You may be invited to conduct a virtual interview with your potential internship supervisor during this stage. This interview will give you an opportunity to showcase your skills, enthusiasm, and cultural adaptability. The interview will be scheduled at a time that best fits your potential supervisor's local time zone.

# What you'll do...

- Check your email daily to ensure you don't miss any communications from your Internship Coordinator regarding the interview and your potential placement.
- "Reply All" to confirm your interview.
- Attend the interview at the scheduled time.

#### **DEADLINE**

Respond to the interview email ASAP, within 48 hours. Be prepared to attend your interview at the scheduled day and time.

## 2 WEEKS

BEFORE YOUR PROGRAM START DATE

# Placement Confirmation Stage

Our team aims to finalize all internship placements at least 14 days before your program begins.

Your main task during this period is to get excited about your upcoming adventure in your host country!

## What you'll do...

Check your email for confirmation of your internship placement from your in-country Internship Coordinator.

#### **DEADLINE**

Check your email daily after your interview to stay updated on the status of your placement and to follow up on any final action steps.
